4. First Aid Measures

Inhalation: If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. 5. Fire Fighting Measures

6. Accidental Release Measures

Wear self-contained breathing apparatus and full protective clothing. With clean shovel, carefully place material into clean, dry container and cover; remove from area. Flush spill area with water.

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7. Handling and Storage

Keep container tightly closed. Store in secure poison area. This chemical has delayed life threatening characteristics that require specific approaches for safe handling including special protective equipment, fume hoods and glove boxes. Strict adherence to OSHA standards, safety programs and protocol systems are required. Containers of this material may be hazardous when empty since they retain product residues (dust, solids); observe all warnings and precautions listed for the product.
